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The purpose of The Sudbury Dog Co. Daycare Centre is to provide a safe, fun, stimulating environment for dogs during weekday business hours. To ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following rules and regulations:

- All dogs over seven months must be spayed or neutered.
- All dogs must be up to date with their vaccinations for Distemper, Hepatitis, Para-influenza, parvovirus and Leptospirosis. Proof of vaccinations must be shown and a record will be kept by the centre. Bordetella (kennel cough) is advised but not a necessity.
- Titre testing will be accepted if a letter from your vet is provided.
- All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 10 days. On admission all dogs must be free from any condition which could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 10 days will require veterinary certification of health to be admitted or re-admitted.
- All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown aggression or threatening behaviour towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember that your dog will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern.

All dogs over the age of six months must undergo a behavioural assessment before being admitted to day care. This assessment is for us to determine how comfortable the dog is with people and other dogs and how suitable he or she is for the environment. This assessment is absolutely necessary for us to ensure that all our guests are kept safe. Not all dogs are suited to a day care environment and we will be honest with any owner if we feel their dog would be unhappy or pose a risk to staff or other dogs.

If we cannot accept your dog at day care we may be able to offer an alternative in the way of a dog walker instead. All behaviour assessments are done without the owner present to allow us to get a true representation of how the dog will behave on a normal day as some dogs behave differently with their owners out of sight.
